The CASC Emeritus Foundation is looking to award students that show a propensity toward leadership in the School Counseling field. This scholarship is available through the generosity of the CASC Board of Directors.

In order to be considered for this scholarship the award applicants must:

- be a member of CASC
- be currently enrolled in a California Graduate School Counseling program
- have completed a minimum of 12 units
- attach a copy of current transcripts
- attach three letters of reference; two from graduate school faculty members and one from a work or volunteer supervisor or an additional graduate school faculty member
- complete an essay
  - addressing your personal experiences that led you to the field of School Counseling
  - describing your leadership experience in the field of School Counseling, and
  - listing any extracurricular activities or community volunteering experience(s) that pertain to the field of School Counseling.

Applications will be judged based on the completed application, the quality of the essay, the submission of transcripts and three letters of recommendation.

The CASC Emeritus Foundation Scholarship winner will be awarded \$2,000.00; a check will be made out to their Graduate School Program to be applied to the student's account. \* The award will be presented at the annual CASC Conference on October 24, 2017.
