## Who Can Apply

Admission criteria for Alliant programs are designed to determine the qualities and capabilities required of professionals in the field to which you are applying. Your academic ability and preparation, along with other personal, non-academic factors, are also considered.

- **Bachelor's Degree:** A bachelor's degree from an accredited university or its international equivalent
- **Resume:** Current resume
- **Essay:** A two-page personal essay describing the professional organizations to which you belong; honors, activities, and other accomplishments; and a brief autobiographical statement including future professional plans
- **Interview:** Video interviews are available
- **English Language Proficiency:** Applicants not previously educated in English must demonstrate English language proficiency. Minimum TOEFL score of 550 paper/213 computer/80 internet or equivalent
- **Other Requirements:** Vary by program

We do not require SAT, ACT, or GMAT scores. All applicants must also complete our application and pay the applicable fee.
